The main tourist attractions are the breathtaking whale watching and unique and fascinating Fraser Island – the largest sand island in the world. ### Day 1 Friday August 3

We make our way to Auckland for our overnight stop tonight before making our way out to the airport for an early flight.

### Day 2 Saturday August 4

### Day 5 Tuesday August 7

As well as coral viewing in the safe waters of Hervey Bay you can snorkel the reef if you wish. Passengers on these trips regularly get to see turtles and dolphins and of course you can feed a variety of fish. Another free afternoon to maybe work on your suntan or check out the shopping.

### Day 6 Wednesday August 8

**BLD**

A big adventure today as we spend the day on Fraser Island, the largest sand island in the world. During this tour you will visit all the highlights of this World Heritage island including the luxuriant rainforest, view pristine freshwater lakes and the long surf pounded beaches. You will even find a NZ connection here with the wreck of the Maheno. Lunch is included on this trip.

### Day 7 Thursday August 9

**BD**

This morning we travel to Maryborough to have a look around this historic rural area. Thursday is the day the Heritage Market is held and there will be plenty of time to examine the treasures here. Another free afternoon today.

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## Day 8 Friday August 10

Today we make our way down to the Gold Coast taking in Noosa Heads, Maroochedore and Caloundra along the way. We overnight on the Gold Coast.

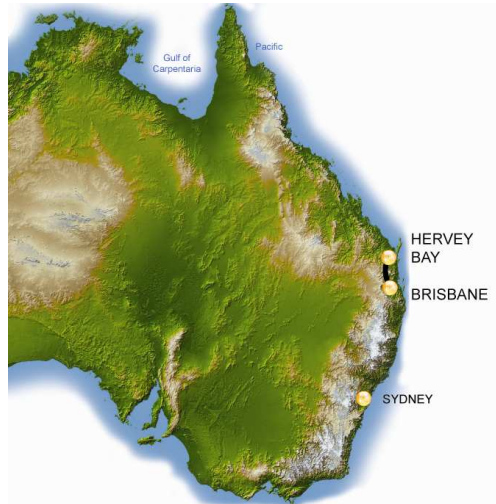
## Day 10 Sunday August 12
